

## **Calendar Committee Report**

The Calendar Committee met on August 24, 2009 to review the draft 2010-2011 school calendar. The draft calendar will be reviewed by the MCPS Educational Leadership Team (ELT) in early October before going to the BOE for approval at the November, 10, 2009, Board meeting. If the ELT makes any changes to the draft discussed last week, Robin Confino will give MCCPTA a heads up before the calendar goes to the BOE.

The draft calendar includes a start date of Monday, August 30, 2010, and ends school on Thursday, June 16, 2011. There will be no school on Tuesday, September 14, 2010, and Tuesday, November 2, 2010, for the primary and general elections and on Friday, October 15, 2010, for the Maryland State Teacher Association Conference. The draft calendar currently includes 3 professional days and 4 half days. Spring break with the Easter holidays is scheduled for April 18-25; Passover falls within this week. These are not final dates until the BOE approves the calendar. There is a half day of school scheduled for the day before Thanksgiving as well as four other half days that will not be finalized until after the BOE approves the calendar.
