The MCCPTA Nominating Committee met on 17 March to review all the potential candidates for executive committee positions with the intention of selecting candidates to put forward to the organization. The members of the nominating committee present reviewed the nominations for AVPs and cluster coordinators received from current officers in compliance with MCCPTA bylaws requirements; those nominations were in by March 15th. Several areas indicated that they had likely nominees, but had been unable to meet prior to the mandated deadline.

All candidates for executive committee positions were discussed. The committee members present then drew up the attached slate which was presented to the Delegates Assembly on March 23, 2010.
