

FINAL EXAMINATION SCHEDULE 2009–2010

The final examination schedule for the 2009–2010 school year is as follows:

First Semester—January 15–22, 2010

Second Semester—June 10–16, 2010

One day of review for end-of-semester examinations should be provided. During this time, teachers should not present new material or schedule tests. This review session may be conducted during regular class periods without a change in the regular schedule. The review is required for English, mathematics, science, social studies, and foreign language classes.

The second semester final examinations or final activity for seniors should be computed into the fourth marking period average by the teacher and should count no more than 25 percent of that grade. The last day for seniors will be May 28, 2010. If the school's graduation exercises are scheduled during the second semester exam window, the school may be permitted to begin the second semester exam window one day earlier. You must consult with the community superintendent if the commencement is within the examination window. Staff members are to be reminded that students should not receive new work or homework during the examination period.

The final examination schedule is to be forwarded to the community superintendent by Friday, September 25, 2009.
