Response

In response to Ms. Brandman's request, the attached chart provides data reflecting the number of students eligible for the Bridge Plan for Academic Validation by high school for each of the four High School Assessment (HSA) subjects (Algebra, English, Biology, and Government). The chart depicts both the total number of eligible students for each subject in each high school, as well as the total number of eligible students expected to graduate in 2009 for each subject in each high school.
